MACHINES, MILITARY EQUIPMENT, AND HYDRAULIC
SYSTEMS. THESE MACHINERIES WERE WORKED ON
CENTURIES AFTER HIM. HE WOULD STUDY ANATOMY AND
DRAW DETAILED SKETCHES WHILE DISSECTING. OVERALL,
LEONARDO'S IDEAS IMPACTED ART, SCIENCE, AND
ENGINEERING.
